



**Vural Gökmen, BSc, MSc, PhD** is professor in the Department of Food Engineering at Hacettepe University, Ankara, Turkey. Professor Gökmen graduated in 1990 with food engineering degree, and gained his PhD degree in 1998. In 2004, he has been awarded as outstanding young scientist by the Turkish Academy of Sciences, and in 2007 he gained science incentive award by The Scientific and

Technological Council of Turkey. In his career Professor Gökmen has carried out national and international research projects related to different aspects of food science. He has collaborated with research groups in Italy, Spain, Germany, France, The Netherlands, USA, UK, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Serbia, Belgium, and Denmark. Professor Gökmen has founded the Food Research Center at Hacettepe University in 2010, and he served as founding director until the end of Feb 2013. Since Aug 2011, Professor Gökmen has been serving as founding president of The National Food Technology Platform of Turkey.

He is a leading expert on food science and has contributed greatly to the understanding of process-derived effects on the quality and safety of foodstuffs. He has also contributed to the development of advanced analytical techniques for the determination of processing contaminants in foods. He has lectured nationally and internationally. To his credit, Professor Gökmen has published over 200 articles, which includes over 180 peer-reviewed manuscripts based on original research, 8 book chapters, and edited a book. As of January 2016, his articles have been cited more than 3200 times according to Web of Science. He has an h-index of 33.

Prof. Gökmen is currently associate editor in **Food Research International**, review editor of **Frontiers in Food Chemistry** and editorial board member in **Food Chemistry, Journal of Food Composition and Analysis** and **Polish Journal**

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**of Food and Nutrition Sciences.** According to Web of Science, Prof. Gökmen is in the list of top 100 authors of the world in the field of Food Science and Technology.
